

How to Host a Game Night Fundraiser



Raise \$150-200

Invite 6-8 people to your house for a Game Night fundraiser. Share why you are raising money for HA. Encourage everyone to join your Games4Brains Team and make their donations to their personal fundraising page.

Example: 6-8 people x \$25 entry fee = \$150-\$250
\$1 Mulligans (re-rolls) x \$5 per person (suggested) = \$30-40



Raise \$400-\$850

Invite 12-24 people to your house (or to an appropriate sized location) for a Game Night fundraiser. Share why you're raising money for HA. Encourage everyone to join your Games4Brains Team and make their donations to their personal fundraising page.

Example: 12-24 people x \$25 entry fee = \$300-\$600
\$1 Mulligans (re-rolls) x \$5 per person (suggested) = \$60-\$120
Raffle/Prizes x \$5 per person (average) = \$60-\$120



Raise \$2000+

Plan a larger, community event that can accommodate up to 100 people. This will require more resources and a larger commitment to produce an event of this nature.

Example: 25-100 people x \$25 entry fee = \$625-\$2,500
Mulligans (re-rolls) x \$5 per person (suggested) = \$125-\$500
Raffle/Prizes x \$5 per person (average) = \$125-\$500
Event Sponsors 4x\$50 = \$200
T-shirts 50 x \$15-20 each = \$750-\$1,000
Food & Beverage x \$25 per person (average) = \$625 - \$2,500
